

Supply List: Boxes and Beyond

Yardage Requirements:

Careful attention to value (lightness/darkness) will make the illusion appear.

- ½ yard each of light, medium and dark fabrics. You can use just three fabrics, or you can use as many as you like for a scrappy look as long as you have equal amounts of lights, mediums and darks. You must be able to cut strips at least 20" long (fat quarters are fine).
- 2 yards background and border fabric. (I like black because it doesn't blend with the boxes or frame values, and because it looks like space, but other colors work also.)

Tools and Notions Required:

- 60° triangle (Sara Nephew makes the best one)
- Cutting mat, 6" x 24" ruler, and cutter with sharp blade
- Sewing machine in good working order
- Sewing basket supplies
- Design wall (flannel, felt, flannel-backed tablecloth, etc) and tape to hang it.

Other Items Highly Recommended:

- Reducing lens, binoculars, or door peephole
