Since this is a no rules/no rulers class, you have a lot of latitude to make this work your own!
Anything goes, so don't worry. You can't make a mistake:-)

Background Fabric

To save time, cut in advance, 16 solid fabric squares from 4"-5" and bring extra of the same solid fabric.

- Any solids are fine in light, medium, or dark. You can't go wrong with neutrals: white, black, gray, brown, beige -- but if you love another color as background and want to work with it, pick whatever you like: darks like olive green, plum, navy, teal or any medium-to-light shade you prefer as a background.

Strips*

Bring any strips in your stash that are already cut, or bring fat quarters or eighths to cut in class: darks, mediums, lights in solids, and any prints: small, large, dots, stripes - whatever you have.

*Strips we cut in class will be freehand cut, without a ruler.

The Usual Suspects

sewing machine

scissors

thread

iron (if not supplied by venue)

rotary cutter and mat

ruler (which you will use only to trim)

seam ripper (just in case)

Other

24" x 36" piece of cotton batting to use as a design wall

blue painter's tape to attach batting to wall.
