- Large Quilt: Length plus width must be at least 121 inches, not to exceed 240 inches, except for Pieced, Made by More than One Person, Category 350.
- Medium Quilt: Category 350 only. Length plus width must be at least 121 inches, not to exceed 160 inches.
- Small Quilt: Length plus width must be at least 30 inches and no more than 120 inches.
- Miniature: Length plus width must be no more than 48 inches; if blocks are used, maximum block size is 5 inches.
- Art Quilts Large: Length plus width must be at least 75 inches and no more than 240 inches
- Art Quilts Small: Length plus width must be less than 75 inches

Make sure to keep a photo for your records and/or for insurance purposes. The Floor Plan Committee uses these photos to coordinate colors and designs to achieve a pleasing arrangement of quilts. The Verification Committee reviews the photos alongside entry forms. Refer to the Photo Tips section in the Quilt Show Procedures for help with taking color-accurate, in-focus photos.

A color photo no smaller than 3" X 5" and no larger than 4" X 6" must be mailed along with the entry form.
