

Supply List

Tile Tango

8" x 8" finished size single flower block.

Fabric

I recommend that you pre-wash and dry all your fabric in a washer and dryer. It will be softer and easier to needle.

If you want to make only one block for class you will need:

- 1 square 10" x 10" for the block background
- A variety of scraps for the applique.

Refer to the Fabric Requirements in the book to make the bigger quilt.



Supplies

You will learn more about all of these supplies in class.

- One 8" x 8" square of medium weight **clear upholstery vinyl**. If the vinyl comes with tissue paper, cut it with the vinyl.
- An **ultra fine point Sharpie** marker in black
- 1 sheet of **clear, heavy weight, single-sided, self-adhesive laminate**.
- A few round wooden toothpicks. I like the ones with a turned/carved wooden end.
- Small **paper scissors**
- Small and medium **fabric scissors**
- **Applique Needles**. I use Clover's #12 Black-Gold Applique needle, Tulip's #11 Applique needle, and/or Clover's #12 Gold-Eye Applique needle
- **Applique pins**. I recommend Bohin's 1/2" sequin pins, Karen K Buckley's Shorter Perfect Pins, and Cover's 3/4" pins.
- **Fine, strong 100% cotton thread**. I recommend Superior's 50wt, 2-ply Masterpiece thread that comes on pre-wound bobbins. Sets are available, as are individual bobbins.
- **General's charcoal pencil in white** for medium-to-dark fabrics.
- I use a firm **Blackwing 602 graphite pencil** for light fabrics. The Extra-Firm Pencil is also a good choice.
- Optional pencil: Sewline or similar 9mm mechanical pencil in white and gray.
- A **sandpaper board** or a sheet of fine grain sandpaper.
- A **sealable bag** for your templates
- A good light.
- Many people find that applique is easier if they have a **Lap App or pillow** to rest their forearms on.
- **Optional book: The Best-Ever Applique Sampler** for detailed hand appliqué instructions
