

EMBROIDERY TEXTURES IN NATURE/ PERSONAL MAPPING

Workshop supply list:

- Fabric: cotton, twill, linen/cotton in a light color, about 12x12"
- 7-8" embroidery hoop
- Floss: a range of basic colors; bring whatever floss you have and add in colors for elements of the natural environment you want to capture.
This could be different greens, blues, colors of flowers or trees. You can choose interpretive or representative colors (for example, make your favorite tree in a groovy bright purple).
- Embroidery needles (a few in sizes similar to the thickness of your floss works best)
- Thread snips
- A fabric safe pen or fine marker for fabric (friction pens are fine for this) or carbon transfer paper.
- A reference image of the place you want to capture (I will email the week before the workshop with more detail about that)
- masking tape or washi tape to for tracing your image (or a lightbox if you have one)
- Optional: yarn in different colors and textures that evoke the environment of your place to be used with couching stitches

Note this is the nice to have list but embroidery is flexible and adaptable so we can work with whatever you have!
