

Just a Little Crazy:

Embellishing a crazy quilt block with multiple techniques

Mary Shepherd has provided a plan for a foundation block for you to embellish.

This block measures 12"x12." The simple drawing is in the attached pdf. The pattern for this block (or, if you choose, an alternate block) should be pieced **BEFORE** the workshop!

Download the file Crazy foundation from the attachment below. The PDF will print out on 4 pieces of ordinary letter paper. It can be taped together. Place a piece of 12"x12" foundation fabric (muslin or other white fabric) over the drawing and trace the lines. Select your crazy quilt fabric and sew using a flip and stitch technique. It is helpful to starch the foundation before piecing.

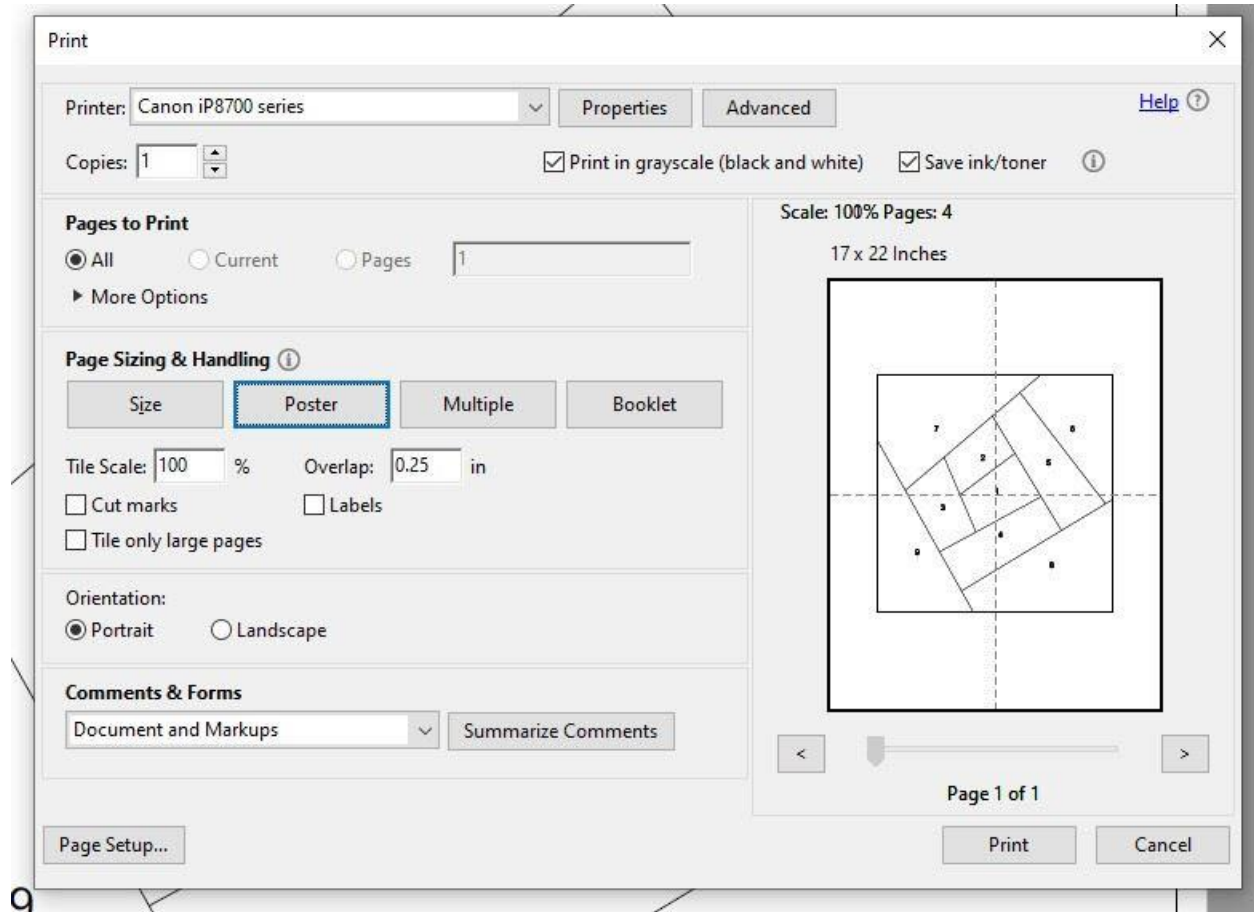

For **correct** printing, **download** the attached file to your computer, then open it in **Adobe Acrobat** Reader. Do not use a tab in your browser or Preview (mac).

Acrobat Reader gives you the print options below. If you are not used to tiling pdfs while printing, please see the following image.

- 1) Select poster.
- 2) Set Tile Scale to 100%.
- 3) The overlap should be set to 0.25in
- 4) The document will print on four pieces of 8.5X11" (letter) paper. Tape the pieces together. The intersecting lines serve as registration marks.
