

# Pine Burr Quilt

84"x 94" (12" blocks)

## *Class Requirements*

### Fabric Requirements

\_\_\_ Background - 4 yards

\_\_\_ Pine Burr Blocks – For scrappy blocks collect a large assortment of fabrics in your color choice. For 30 identical blocks use the following:

Centers: 1 yard

Cones: 1 yard

Sawtooths points: 2½ yard

Sawtooth background: 2½ yard

### Optional Pieced Border

\_\_\_ Saw tooth points 1½ yards

\_\_\_ Background 1½ yards

### Supplies:

\_\_\_ Sewing machine in working order

\_\_\_ Freezer paper

\_\_\_ Fabric and paper scissors

\_\_\_ Stapler and staple remover

\_\_\_ Pins – Regular quilter pins

\_\_\_ Add-a-Quarter Ruler

\_\_\_ Rotary Cutting Rulers, your favorites

\_\_\_ Cutting mat

\_\_\_ Rotary cutter

\_\_\_ Thread to match

\_\_\_ Several filled bobbins

\_\_\_ Seam ripper

\_\_\_ Machine needles

\_\_\_ Pencil and notebook

\_\_\_ It is helpful to have a cutting mat and small iron near your sewing machine.



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# Pine Burr Pre-Cutting

Sawtooth Units- For each block cut:

Light background fabric- Cut 20 –  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut diagonally

Dark fabric – 16 –  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut diagonally

Four  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x4" pieces for diamond points

Multiply by the number of blocks you'll be making.

The other pine burr pieces will be cut in class.
