Pine Burr Pre-Cutting

Sawtooth Units- For each block cut:

Light background fabric− Cut 20 − 2½" squares, cut diagonally

Dark fabric $-16 - 2\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut diagonally Four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x4" pieces for diamond points

Multiply by the number of blocks you'll be making.

The other pine burr pieces will be cut in class.
