<u>Cutting Instructions</u>

TO BE DONE IN CLASS!

Sky	cut one rectangle 4"L x 9"- 18"(max)
Mountains	free form cut ONE or SEVERAL strips with either gentle curves or angles* approximately 2 " x width of the sky
Hills/ Meadow	free form cut SEVEN strips with a gentle curve approximately 4"L x width of the sky
River	cut ONE rectangle 4"L x width of the sky (no curve)
Wildflowers	free form cut ONE strip with a gentle curve approximately 4"L x width of the sky

*Distant mountains can consist of one rolling hill or several layers of dramatic alpine peaks.

- 1. ONE ROLLING HILL: cut one gently curved 2"strip to suggest the distant hill.
- 2. ALPINE MOUNTAIN RANGE: select 3-6 fabrics gradated from dark to light. Choose colors that are slightly grayed in either blues, green, purples, browns or grays (and whites for snow capped mountains). Cut 2" strips with irregular angles.

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
