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## Cutting Instructions

## TO BE DONE IN CLASS!

| Sky | cut one rectangle 4"L x 9"-18"(max) |
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| Mountains | free form cut ONE or SEVERAL strips with either <br> gentle curves or angles* <br> approximately 2" x width of the sky |
| Hills/ <br> Meadow | free form cut SEVEN strips with a gentle curve <br> approximately 4"L x width of the sky |
| River | cut ONE rectangle 4"L x width of the sky (no curve) |
| Wildflowers | free form cut ONE strip with a gentle curve <br> approximately 4"L x width of the sky |

*Distant mountains can consist of one rolling hill or several layers of dramatic alpine peaks.

1. ONE ROLLING HILL: cut one gently curved 2"strip to suggest the distant hill.
2. ALPINE MOUNTAIN RANGE: select 3-6 fabrics gradated from dark to light. Choose colors that are slightly grayed in either blues, green, purples, browns or grays (and whites for snow capped mountains). Cut 2" strips with irregular angles.
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
